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Example:	One student says: "I am 14 years old. I was born in Nantucket, USA. I have a pet dog. I hate dark chocolate."
	The other could ask: "Do you love milk chocolate?", "Are you 15?", "Do you speak English?", etc. If student number 1 answers that he/she does not speak EN, then being born in the USA becomes slightly unlikely.
