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Aim	To strengthen collaboration and to create an atmosphere
	of inclusivity. The method works as ice-breaker among
	teachers and students.
Duration of activity	10-30 (depends on the number of people involved and the
(min)	amount of questions)
Necessary materials	The associative cards with different images.

Action description	This method can be used for various type of work with
	young people. The teacher can be creative with creating different tasks for students using cards. For example, to create his/her own goal map, to express his/her dreams, to find out the different solutions of problems. The advantage of the method is its versatility it can be used in groups as well as individually. It is important if there is a need to discuss a question. Activity starts with question, for example, "What is your dream career?" The student then has to choose one associative card and show and explain to the group his/her choice.
Result	The usage of associative cards in the groups promotes the
	skill of communication and dialog between involved participants. Associative cards helps to express feelings,
	opinion and helps to tell about self-growth, empathy and
	develops active listening skills and story telling skills.
	The method allows to see person's resources and barriers
	in a projective way, it promotes creative problem solving
	and develops imagination.
When to use	The method is useful when learners need to get to know
	each other thoroughly. The method is useful in problem







	solving situations that challenge thinking and require creativity.
	The method is universal. It is applicable in cases when there is a need to assess a problem/ situation from various perspectives in order to come up with new ideas, interesting discussions.
Conclusion	These cards help young people to develop creative thinking. The method helps to solve problems and to find solutions within the group. It develops self-awareness. The classmates acquire the skill of cooperation and they get to know each other better.
