





## Method: "Positive attitude towards subject"

Aim	To increase positive attitude towards subject.
<b>Duration of</b>	10
activity (min)	
Necessary	Game dices "Max Rorys Story Cubes" (9 dices with images on
materials	every side)
Action	At the beginning of lesson the teacher informs the students
description	about the aim of the activity: to increase positive attitude
	towards a subject. The teacher divides the class into groups of
	four. Each group raffles the sequence of operations. The task of
	each group is to:
	- throw 9 dices;
	- make the story using images on the game dices;
	- include the themes of the study course in the created
	story.
	Assessment.
	The rest of the class and teacher evaluates story using scale from 1
	till 10 (1-the lowest grade and 10 – the highest grade). After 5 days teacher summarizes the grades of groups and gives a prize. The kind
	of prize depends on teacher's choice.
	At the end of lesson teacher expresses gratitude for well done work
	and for created positive attitude and revealed difficulties.
Result	After participating in the game the student has reduced anxiety
	and feels uplifted and has been able to speak up about
	encountered difficulties in the course.
When to use	10 min before lesson, five days – each day by day.
Conclusion	This method helps to verbalize any bottled up negative
	emotions the student may have felt due to the course. This helps
	to process the negative emotions by sharing in a creative and
	fun way through a game thus it fosters a more positive attitude
	and understanding.
