Method name:	Speaking- ice breakers
In what subject/s you can adapt this method:	This method can be used for teaching primarily foreign languages
General description of the method in a few sentences:	<b>True or False</b> – is a method can easily “melt the ice“ with a new class when the students still aren’t familiar with each other and especially effective with students who feel too shy to talk in front of the class. By using this provocative game they can easily practice both their speaking and vocabulary on different topics of general knowledge.
Detailed description of the method:	
1.Step	The student has to tell his/her partner 4 things about themselves, their family, home town, including one fact which is false.
2.Step	The partnering student has to ask <b>Yes/ No</b> questions and guesses which one is false.
3.Step	The activity is repeated after exchanging the roles.

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<b>Example:</b>	<p>One student says: "I am 14 years old. I was born in Nantucket, USA. I have a pet dog.
